Youth Showmanship Show – 12:30 – 1:00 PM in the Show Ring

The Youth Showmanship Show is open to all exhibitors 16 years old or younger with fiber-bearing caprine (Angora, Cashmere, Cashgora, and Pygora) from the state of Maine. Animals do not need to be registered with any association for this show. Judging is based on animal presentation and handling in the ring. The judge may ask participants about general goat care & handling. Goats need not be owned by the participant or her/his family for this class. Any age/sex/breed fiber goat may be entered.

Schedule: 9:00-12:00 – Fleece and conformation evaluation in the goat barn
1:00 PM - Cashmere Goat Evaluation & Show in the Show Ring

Judging is based on conformation & fiber quality/production as set forth in the Standard for North American Cashmere Goat available at the ECA website. Classes will be divided by sex (does, & bucks and/or age). Those showing cashmere goats in the open class should bring the animal's combing/clip from the current year. The score sheet from the show can be used to register your Goat with the North American Cashmere Goat registry. Does, bucks, and wethers can be shown. Premiums and ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in each class and grand and reserve champion.
